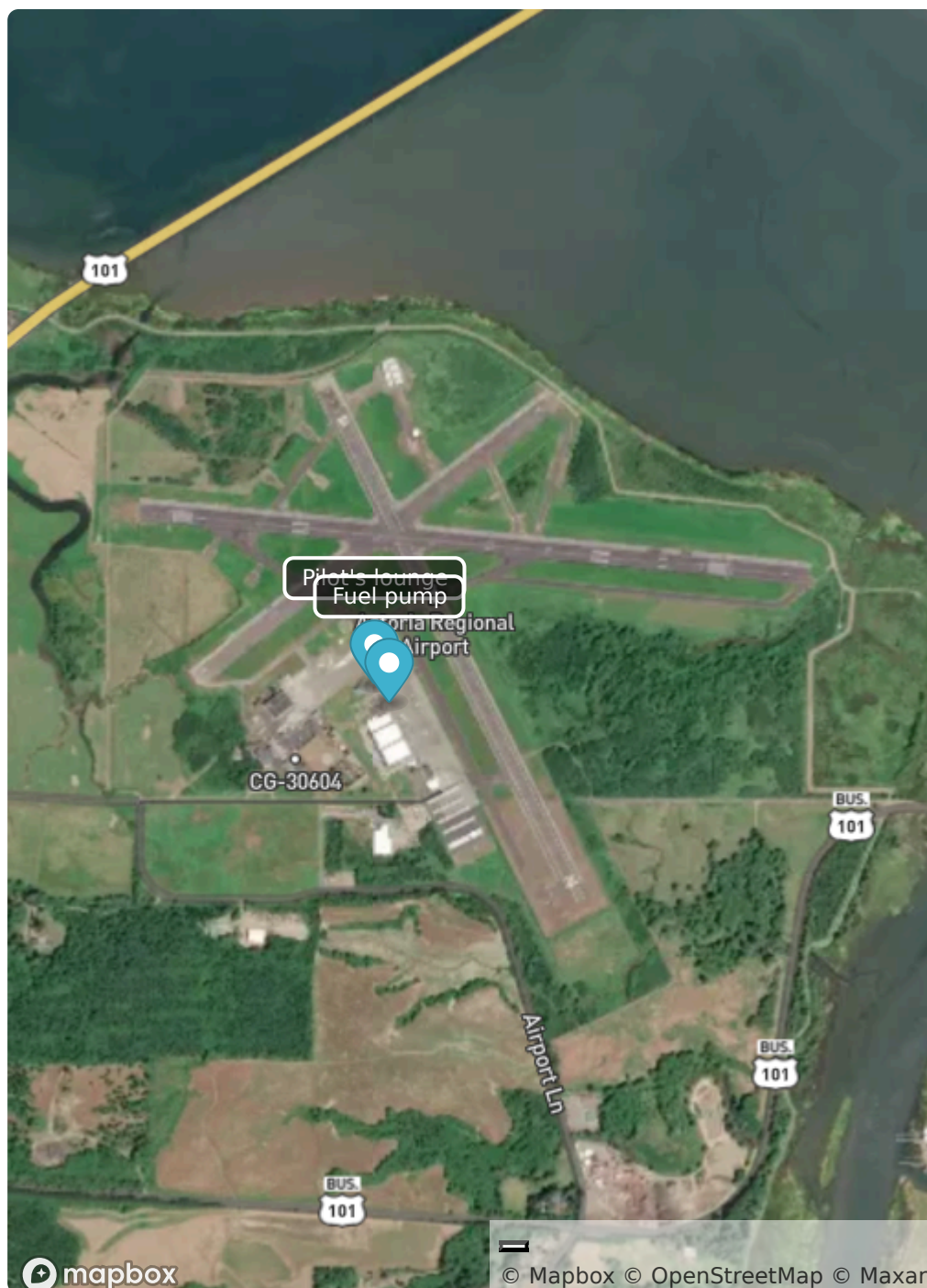
As of 2024 KAST has been very aggressive on keeping fuel prices low.
